The Aurora Borealis is most commonly seen in the polar regions, within a radius of 1,550 miles around the magnetic poles. This area is known as the Auroral Zone or the Auroral Oval. For the Northern Lights, the further north you travel the more likely you are to catch a glimpse of the aurora.

The best months to see the Aurora Borealis in Canada are from October to March (most hours of darkness). However, if we want to see the Northern Lights in Canada in August or another summer month, a high KP in the southern parts (still fewer hours of darkness) would give you the best chances to see Aurora Borealis.

Tips on photographing the Aurora Borealis with your DSLR. Try to use a camera that allows high ISO-settings and minimal noise levels. Use optics with a maximum aperture for shooting at night; Take the photos in RAW-format so you can reduce noise afterward.

This is not the goal for photographing the Northern Lights, we want, vivid color and nice detail. Keeping your shutter speed between 3-25 seconds will work very well for shooting the northern lights. When the aurora is moving quickly, try 3-7 second exposures. When it’s moving slower, or it’s not as bright, try 10-25 seconds.
